


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

Histone H3 (H3) Antibody

Western blot analysis of extracts of various cell lines, using HIST3H3 antibody (abx001905) at 1/1000 dilution.



Chromatin Immunoprecipitation analysis extracts of HeLa cell line, using HIST3H3 antibody (abx001905) and rabbit IgG. The amount of immunoprecipitated DNA was checked by quantitative PCR. Histogram was constructed by the ratios of the immunoprecipitated DNA to the input.

Histone H3 Antibody is a Rabbit Polyclonal antibody against Histone H3. Histones are basic nuclear proteins that are responsible for the nucleosome structure of the chromosomal fiber in eukaryotes. Nucleosomes consist of approximately 146 bp of DNA wrapped around a histone octamer composed of pairs of each of the four core histones (H2A, H2B, H3, and H4). The chromatin fiber is further compacted through the interaction of a linker histone, H1, with the DNA between the nucleosomes to form higher order chromatin structures. This gene is intronless and encodes a member of the histone H3 family. Transcripts from this gene lack polyA tails; instead, they contain a palindromic termination element. This gene is located separately from the other H3 genes that are in the histone gene cluster on chromosome 6p22-p21.3.
