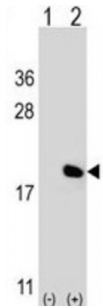


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## Interleukin 17A (IL17A) Antibody

The protein encoded by this gene is a proinflammatory cytokine produced by activated T cells. This cytokine regulates the activities of NF-kappaB and mitogen-activated protein kinases. This cytokine can stimulate the expression of IL6 and cyclooxygenase-2 (PTGS2/COX-2), as well as enhance the production of nitric oxide (NO). High levels of this cytokine are associated with several chronic inflammatory diseases including rheumatoid arthritis, psoriasis and multiple sclerosis.

**Target:** IL17A

**Reactivity:** Human

**Host:** Rabbit

**Clonality:** Polyclonal

**Tested Applications:** WB

**Recommended dilutions:** Optimal dilutions/concentrations should be determined by the end user.

**Immunogen:** Human IL17A.

**Purification:** Peptide Affinity Purified Rabbit Polyclonal Antibody.

**Isotype:** IgG

**Conjugation:** Unconjugated

**Specificity:** This IL17A antibody is generated from rabbits immunized with a KLH conjugated synthetic peptide between 61-87 amino acids from the Central region of human IL17A.

**Storage:** Aliquot and store at -20 °C. Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles.

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**Buffer:** PBS with 0.09% (W/V) sodium azide. This antibody is purified through a protein A column, followed by peptide affinity purification.
