




Western blot analysis of (1) Human Serum, (2) Human Liver Tissue, (3) Human Lung Tissue and (4) Mouse Testis Tissue.




Western blot analysis of recombinant Human DBP.

IHC-P analysis of Human Liver Cancer Tissue, with DAB staining.




IHC-P analysis of Human Prostate Gland Tissue, with DAB staining.
