This product was prepared from normal serum by delipidation, salt fractionation, ion exchange chromatography followed by papain digestion and extensive dialysis against the buffer stated above. Assay by immunoelectrophoresis resulted in a single precipitin arc against anti-Sheep IgG, anti-Sheep IgG F(ab')₂ and anti-Sheep Serum. No reaction was observed against anti-Sheep IgG F(c) or anti-Papain.
