

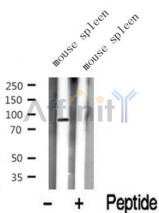

Reactivity:	Human,Mouse,Rat
Purification:	The antiserum was purified by peptide affinity chromatography using SulfoLink™ Coupling Resin (Thermo Fisher Scientific).
Specificity:	TPOR Ab detects endogenous levels of TPOR.
Immunogen:	A synthesized peptide derived from human TPOR.
Uniprot:	P40238
Subcellular Location:	Membrane.
Tissue Specificity:	Expressed at a low level in a large number of cells of hematopoietic origin. Isoform 1 and isoform 2 are always found to be coexpressed.
Similarity:	The WSXWS motif appears to be necessary for proper protein folding and thereby efficient intracellular transport and cell-surface receptor binding.The box 1 motif is required for JAK interaction and/or activation.Belongs to the type I cytokine receptor family. Type 1 subfamily.
Storage Condition and Buffer:	Rabbit IgG in phosphate buffered saline , pH 7.4, 150mM NaCl, 0.02% sodium azide and 50% glycerol.Store at -20 °C.Stable for 12 months from date of receipt.



Western blot analysis of TPOR in lysates of mouse spleen, using TPOR Ab(AF4729).

IMPORTANT: For western blot, incubate membrane with diluted primary Ab in 5% w/v milk , 1X TBS, 0.1% Tween@20 at 4°C with gentle shaking, overnight.



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
