Physical Appearance and Stability	ATF4 is supplied as a sterile filtered clear solution. Store at 4°C if entire vial will be used within 2-4 weeks. Store, frozen at -20°C for longer periods of time. For long term storage it is recommended to add a carrier protein (0.1% HSA or BSA).Avoid multiple freeze-thaw cycles.
Formulation and Purity	ATF4 protein solution (0.5mg/ml) containing 20mM Tris-HCl buffer (pH 8.0), 1mM DTT and 10% glycerol. Greater than 90.0% as determined by SDS-PAGE.
