Formulation: Lyophilized in a 20 mM Phosphate, pH 7.5 solution

Appearance: Tan Powder

Specific Activity: Typically >75 U/mg powder @ 37°C

Unit Definition: One unit will hydrolyze one micromole of ethyl butyrate and ethanol per minute at pH 7.4 and 37°C.

Storage & Stability: Store at -20°C. 1 year.
