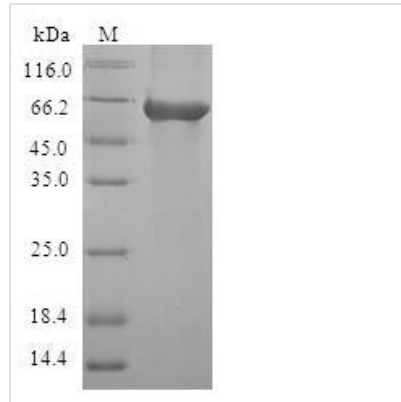




Recombinant Human Carbonic anhydrase-related protein(CA8)
