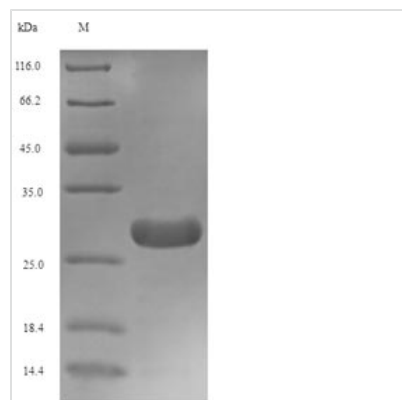




# Recombinant *Xenopus laevis* Transforming growth factor beta-1 (tgfb1)

<b>Relevance</b>	Important role in certain aspects of differentiation.
<b>Storage</b>	The shelf life is related to many factors, storage state, buffer ingredients, storage temperature and the stability of the protein itself. Generally, the shelf life of liquid form is 6 months at -20°C/-80°C. The shelf life of lyophilized form is 12 months at -20°C/-80°C.
