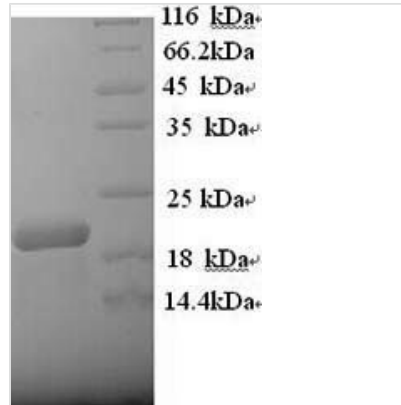




# Recombinant Human B-lymphocyte antigen CD20(MS4A1),partial

<b>Relevance</b>	This protein may be involved in the regulation of B-cell activation and proliferation.
<b>Storage</b>	The shelf life is related to many factors, storage state, buffer ingredients, storage temperature and the stability of the protein itself. Generally, the shelf life of liquid form is 6 months at -20°C/-80°C. The shelf life of lyophilized form is 12 months at -20°C/-80°C.
