Relevance	Confers resistance to many beta-lactam antibiotics, including some carbapens. Does not confer resistance to the polymixin colistin or the fluoroquinolone ciprofloxacin.
Storage	The shelf life is related to many factors, storage state, buffer ingredients, storage temperature and the stability of the protein itself. Generally, the shelf life of liquid form is 6 months at -20°C/-80°C. The shelf life of lyophilized form is 12 months at -20°C/-80°C.
