
## PTF1A Antibody, Rabbit PAb, Antigen Affinity Purified







Immunogen:	A synthetic peptide corresponding to the C-terminus of the Human PTF1A
Preparation	Produced in rabbits immunized with a synthetic peptide corresponding to the C-terminus of the Human PTF1A, and purified by antigen affinity chromatography.

Specificity:	Human Mouse (Species predicted to react based on 100% sequence homology)
Formulation:	0.2 µm filtered solution in PBS
Storage:	This antibody can be stored at $2^{\circ}\text{C}-8^{\circ}\text{C}$ for one month without detectable loss of activity. Antibody products are stable for twelve months from date of receipt when stored at $-20^{\circ}\text{C}$ to $-80^{\circ}\text{C}$ . Preservative-Free. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.


## PTF1A Antibody, Rabbit PAb, Antigen Affinity Purified

Immunofluorescence staining of PTF1A in HeLa cells. Cells were fixed with 4% PFA, permeabilzed with 0.3% Triton X-100 in PBS,blocked with 10% serum, and incubated with rabbit anti-human PTF1A polyclonal antibody (1:5000) at 4°C overnight. Then cells were stained with the Alexa Fluor®488-conjugated Goat Anti-rabbit IgG secondary antibody (green) and counterstained with DAPI (blue). Positive staining was localized to cytoplasm and nucleus.
